

Captured in Mali at Yeelen Studios during the 2012 coup d'etat, the sessions feature West African heavyweights Khaira Arby, Adama Dramé, Bassekou Kouyate, Boubacar Sidibé, & Vieux Farka Touré collaborating with Northern California/New Orleans livewire JeConte, in an exciting border crossing musical exploration.

The album is a call for peace in Mali delivered through hypnotically soulful tunes that merge West African rhythms, Reggae strains and Afro-Pop grooves with seductive New Orleans Blues and earthy California Rock n' Roll. Look for two additional releases 'Laido' & 'Warriko' coming from the Mali Blues Sessions coming summer 2014.

**JeConte** brings his lightening harmonica chops and a deep, bluesy vocal style to the band. His performance is a one-of-a-kind, high vibrational musical experience, embodying what live, funky, bluesy-rock is all about. Residing in Northern California and having spent a great deal of time in New Orleans, Louisiana, he has played with multiple bands over the years and believes that JeConte & the Mali Allstars is a culmination of these efforts. JeConte is touring with his own project at festivals and clubs throughout the United States. He is currently working on his sophmore JeConte release **'Down by the Bayou'** with singer songwriter **Anders Osborne** - Spring 2014



**Boubacar Sidibé** is one of the leading members of the Mali Allstars. Referred to as 'Crow' by members of the band, or 'old wise man,' and he contributes years of World touring experience and outstanding musical leadership. He performs 'lefty' on a right-handed rhythm guitar and brings his beautiful melodic voice and chromatic harmonica to the group. Boubacar is best known as the rhythm guitar player for **Habib Koité's** band, **Bamada**. He brings years of soulful songwriting to the Mali Allstars, with amazing guitar and harmonica licks, a 'do not miss' performance indeed.



**Adama Dramé** is the lead guitar player for multiple bands throughout Mali, and a force to be reckoned with. Considered by many as the 'Jimi Hendrix' of Mali, he has an amazing, lightening guitar style, playing with his teeth and delivers an 'out of this world' live performance. Adama Dramé has toured throughout Africa with **Toumani Diabate, Fantani Touré**, **Charlie Arby** and multiple other bands over the past decade. He brings his non-stop energy to The Mali Allstars and contributes his years of musical knowledge, original songwriting, lead guitar and n'goni playing to live performances and Mali Blues.



**Sil Matadin**, is a bass player virtuoso and dynamic performer with a wealth of musical knowledge. Sil plays throughout the World and performs internationally with world-renowned singer **Hindi Zahra** and also **Archie Shepp.** He is a phenomanal musician, and when not touring internationally, he is furiously working away in his home studio, in Paris. He joined JeConte & the Mali Allstars for multiple Paris gigs in 2012 and throughout the 2013 European Summer Tour. He is currently working on the intracies of **The Mali Blues Trio's** live album **Ibiza Blues** with JeConte and is ready to hit the road in 2014.



**Mamadou Kone** is JeConte & the Mali Allstars' 'Mad Percussionist.' He is a master at percussion and also plays traditional n'gone. He performs on the traditional Malian bass drum, the Kalabash and the 'talking drum', and a multitude of other percussive devices that he pulls from his bag-of-tricks. Mamadou, a long-time member of **Habib Koité's** band, Bamada, has toured internationally with **Habib Koité** for the past ten years. He also performs throughout Mali in many other projects. Mamadou brings an incredible infectious energy to the Mali Allstars' live performance with his wireless talking-drum magic.



**Erick Borevla** is one of Paris' top gigging drummers, playing throughout Paris on multiple projects and active on the national & international scene. He has played with such artists as **The Last Poets**, **Archie Shepp**, & **Eugene Chadbourne**, to name a few. His style ranges from progressive Rock & Traditional Jazz, to Funk, Blues, Soul, Afro-Pop and Reggae. He has been on over 50 records during his career as a session drummer and has traveled throughout West Africa and the African continent studying and mastering his craft.

Please note that due to travel restrictions, touring conflicts and possible visas issues, some of the above members may change for live performances, however JeConte will always bring a band that exceeds crowd expectations.


